The School Council help around school and we are involved in regular events at school.

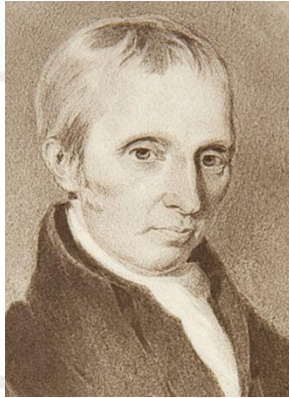
Last year's project:

We want you to design a school crest for your new school house and come up with a motto that will be associated with your house.



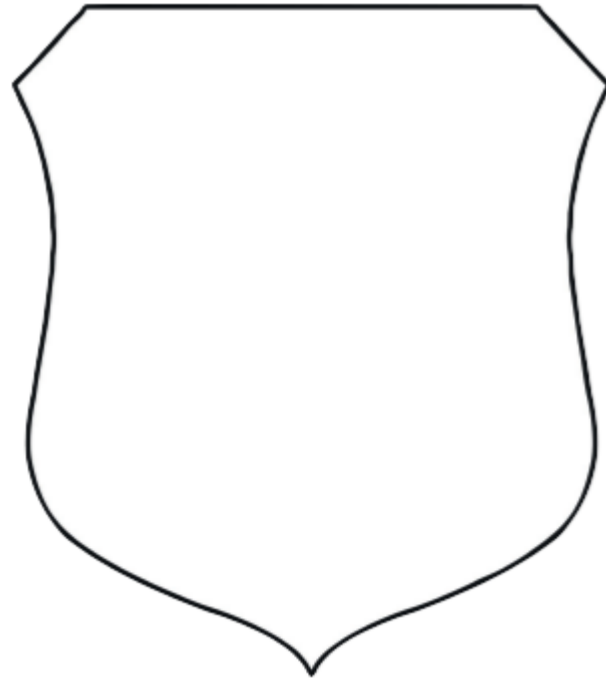
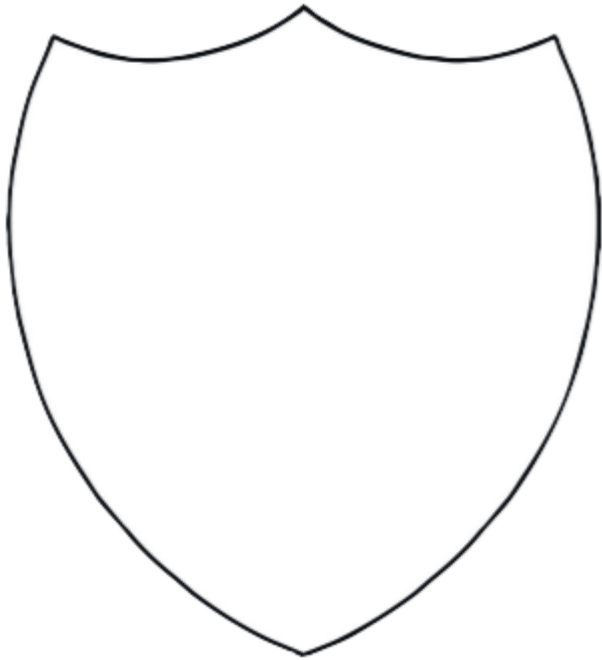
What's a motto?

- Leading with the Heart

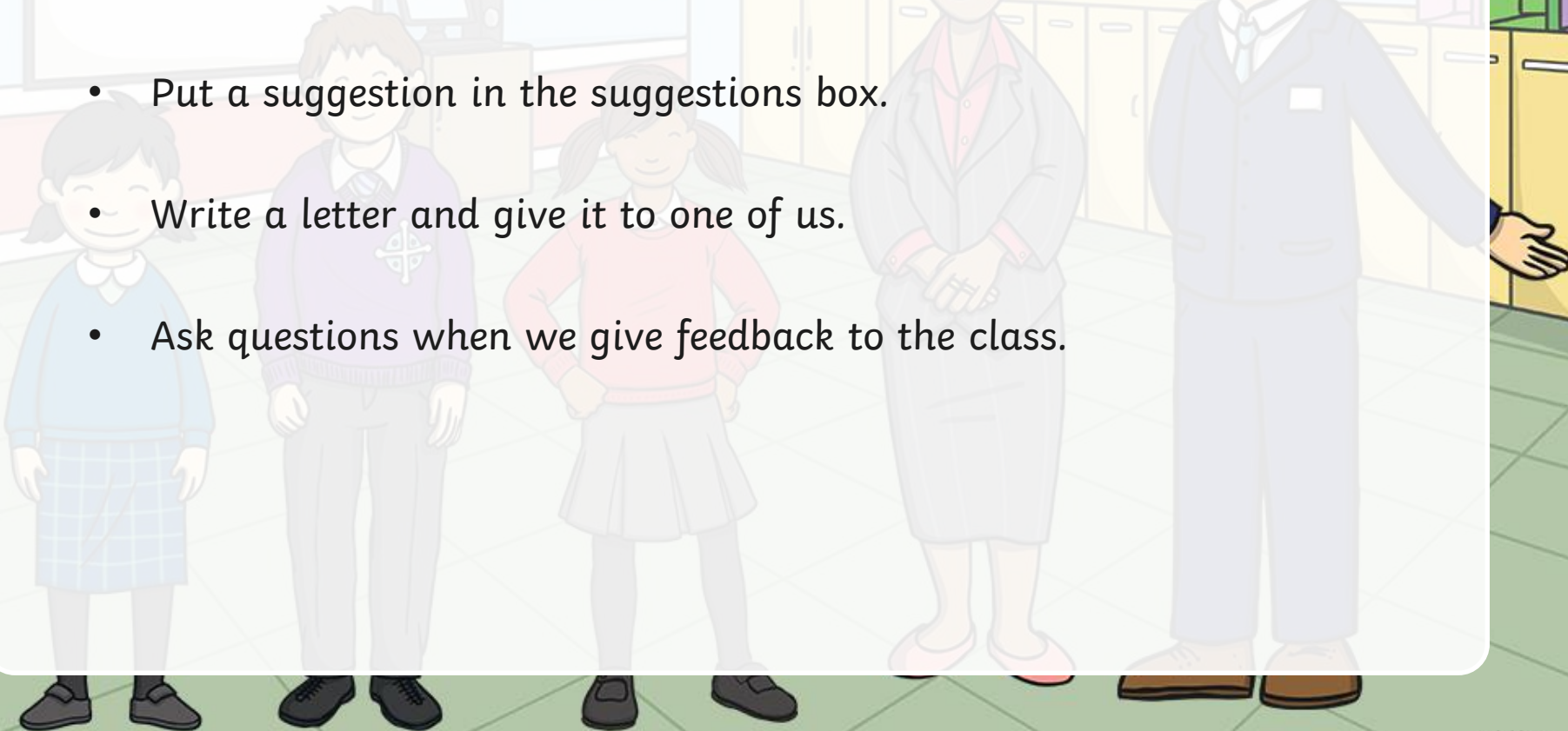
Submit your crest design and motto to your school council rep.
