Who is invited?

What happened at the first meeting?

We held our first meeting the other week. We talked about what parents feel is going well, what we can improve and also any other suggestions. It also gave parents a chance to ask us questions especially connected to the school expansion, the vision and direction we are taking the school in.

Feedback from parents...

What's going well? Parents felt that the school has become more dynamic. It is a happier place to be and children are more engaged and identify with the school more. The changes to the playground have been overwhelmingly positive with all children really enjoying the activities and access to all areas. Parents felt that the handwriting is improving this year. The calendar and club timetable have also been really helpful. The newsletters are informative.

What can we improve? Some parent felt there was more of an academic focus this year. This was not necessarily a bad thing but it was good to have the opportunity to talk about the expectations in the curriculum and how important it is that we prepare our children for the challenges that they face. Parents expressed a desire for further clarity on how things are done here. This is something that we can certainly work on. We are conscious to aim for consistency across the school and increasing our information sharing so that clarity is achieved.
