Early Years Foundation Stage

Children are expected to make a good overall development in the early learning goals (ELG) Prime Areas, (personal, social & emotional development; physical development and communication & language) and ELG Specific Areas of Mathematics and Literacy. The table below shows the percentage of children who achieved the national expectation in our school compared with South Glos. Schools.

Due to the commitment and dedication of our Early Years Team the percentage of children meeting a good overall development continues to exceed the local figures.

Phonics - In Year 1 children are assessed in using their phonological knowledge to read words and are expected to reach a specific standard using national material. The table below shows the percentage of children who achieved the expected standard in comparison with local and national figures.

KS1 End of Key Stage Assessment:

The national expectation is that children achieve level 2b in Reading, Writing and Mathematics by the end of Year 2. The table below shows the percentage of children who achieved 2b or above and level 3 in comparison with local and national figures.

We are extremely proud of the results our **20 children** achieved this year. Results show they continue to achieve **above** the local and national figures for 2b+ in Reading and Writing.

KS2 End of Key Stage Standard Assessment Test results:

The national expectation is that children achieve level 4 in English and Mathematics at the end of Year 6. This is carried out through a formal test that is externally marked. The table below shows the percentage of children who achieved level 4 or above and level 5 in comparison with local and national figures.

An impressive year for these **18 children**, showing **excellent** results and we are so proud of them. Results are **exceeding** national average for level 4 and **exceeding** for level 5 in all areas except Maths where we are in line. We are exceptionally pleased with our level 5 Reading. There are no national figures for Science as children have not been required to sit a Science test since 2009. The school and local figures are based on teacher assessment.

Progress:

Children are expected to make 2 levels progress from Key Stage 1 (KS1) to Key Stage 2 (KS2) e.g. from Level 2 to Level 4 in Reading, Writing and Maths. Our Year 6 children this year **all** made 2 levels progress in Reading, Writing and Maths.
